



QUINN, JOHN JACKSON

John Jackson Quinn (Grandpa Quinn), who celebrated his one-hundredth birthday, October 8th and who was famous as the oldest living democrat in the State, died this morning at ten o'clock, at his home in Layton. About 3:00 o'clock this morning, his grandson, Leroy Scarlett, heard him moan and went into his room. He wrapped him up warmly and brought him to the fire. A tonic was administered, but the old patriot gradually sank into a stupor from which he never rallied and peacefully passed away. The funeral has not been announced at this time, but will take place as soon as several of his children can be heard from
